


Jesus Ascends Into Heaven

Jesus Ascends — bible craft

You will need:

- * One large plastic blue cup or paper cup painted or coloured blue.
- * 12" wool or string
- * Cotton wool
- * Printable Jesus (below) and memory verse (Acts 1:11)
- * Safety scissors
- * Tape and glue



**This Jesus, who was taken
from you into heaven,
will come back in the same
way that you saw him go
to heaven.**

Acts 1:11

Method:


1. Glue small pieces of cotton wool to the outside of the blue cup so they look like fluffy clouds in the sky.
2. Carefully poke a hole in the bottom of the blue cup (ask an adult to do this safely for you).
2. Insert wool or string through the hole in the bottom of the cup.
3. Cut out the Jesus figure and tape it to the bottom of the wool or string.
4. Cut out the memory verse cloud and tape it to the other end of the wool or string.
5. Now you can pull on the cloud verse and watch Jesus ascend into the sky up to heaven.

Up In a Cloud craft



You will need:

- * Jesus and disciples figures (below)
- * Cloud (below)
- * Scissors
- * Tape
- * Wool or string (approximately 20 inches long)
- * Hole-punch
- * Cotton wool balls
- * Glue
- * Crayons




Method:

1. Ask an adult to help you cut out the large cloud, pictures of Jesus and his disciples.
2. Glue the disciples onto the hillside landscape picture on page 3.
3. Punch a hole in the centre top and bottom of the empty landscape scene on page 3
4. Thread the piece of wool or string through each hole. Tie off the ends of the wool or string in the back near to the top hole.
5. Tape Jesus to the piece of wool or string on the front.
6. Glue cotton wool onto the sky to look like the clouds.
7. Turn the cloud over and ask an adult to help you put glue on the right and left side of the large cloud. Attach it to your picture loosely across the wool or string so that it leaves a gap which allows for Jesus to easily be pulled up behind it.
8. You can then pull the wool or string in the back to move Jesus from standing on the ground with His disciples, to ascend up to heaven in a cloud.

H is for Heaven


You will need:

- * Page 5 colouring sheet
- * Blue pencils or blue paint
- * White pencils or white crayons
- * Cotton wool balls
- * Glue

Method:

1. Fill the "H" shape with glue
2. Break off pieces of cotton wool and stick them on the glue to make a "H" shaped cloud
3. Colour or paint the rest of the page blue
4. Use white pencils or crayons to create wispy clouds

Jesus came back from the grave and spent 40 days with his beloved disciples. He taught his dear followers many things and told them that he would visit again.




He said, "Soon, you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit and receive the power of God. You will tell my story to the people in Jerusalem and to people all over the Earth."

3. Use a hand puppet or finger puppets to tell the story.




4. Use a pen (make sure it is a washable ink pen) to draw a simple face on your fingers). Use this as a puppet to tell the story.
